Cody, U.S. Marine injured by improvised explosive device while serving in Afghanistan. Cody and Willie are going to college at LMU.





LOOKING TO 2014

Going into 2014, we will continue to serve those in need while pursuing accreditation in Assistance Dogs International (a coalition of service dog organizations who subscribe to the "highest level" of ethics, training, and facility management procedures). Once accredited, SMSD will be the only member headquartered in a twelve (12) state area serving disabled veterans. We will continue to work diligently developing relationships with Warrior Transition Units where many of our injured recover. In addition, we will be doing in-service workshops at Veteran Administration Facilities as they manage the long term care of our wounded warriors. On the autism side, we will be working closely with the **Kelly Autism Program at WKU to** better understand how service dogs can be better trained and utilized to interrupt many destructive stimming behaviors. To this end, the Kelly **Autism Program is conducting** research with CanDoo and his interactions with the facility's autistic children.
